2015 - 2016 NHS Membership Volunteer/Service Requirements: 18 hours

Returning Members: You may count any hours earned from May 1, 2015 through April 30, 2016 as "2015-2016 Required" hours.

Newly Inducted Members: You may count any hours earned after the date of your induction through April 30, 2016 as "2015-2016 Required" hours.

No more than 9 summer hours (prior to August 2015) can count toward your "required 18 NHS hours."

Hours submitted for NHS cannot "Double Dip" with required hours submitted for another group (MAT, Key Club, Tri-M, ITS, JROTC). *TN Scholars does not count as "Double Dipping."

3 Hours - School Service	Must be performed in service to a CMCSS school
3 Hours - NHS Service	Must be earned by serving during a CHS NHS Sponsored service activity (Concessions, Wildcat Trail, Paint Days, New NHS Candidate Mentoring, Induction)
6 Hours - Community (Secular or Religious)	May be performed in service to any non-school
6 Hours - Personal Choice	You may decide how to earn your remaining six hours.
*Tennessee Scholars	You must document a minimum of 80 hours prior to April 1st of your senior year. At least 40 of these hours must be something other than "church" service hours.

**If a NHS Member falls out of "good standing," the member may be assigned additional "required" hours to resolve probationary penalty requirements.
Missed Meetings = 3 hours each; Write-Ups = 5 hours each; Late Dues/Fees = 3 hours each; etc.

You may NOT count the following as Volunteer/Service activities:

- *Court-Ordered Community Service Activities or other Disciplinary Service
- *Obligatory Service required to receive a grade or credit for an academic course.
- *Service done for a political campaign or sponsored by a candidate for political gain.
- *Service performed for a family member (immediate or extended) or a family member's business.
- *Service that primarily benefits a family member and/or his/her business.
- *Service for which you have received payment or another form of direct compensation (barter, time for trade, etc.).
- Note being fed a meal during a volunteer shift or being given uniformed attire for service does not constitute payment.

*NHS Members found to be falsifying Volunteer/Service Documentation will be referred to the NHS Faculty Council to have NHS Membership **revoked**.
NHS volunteer/service verification documentation is routinely checked to ensure credibility.*
