Yearbook –Baby Pictures (8th grade)

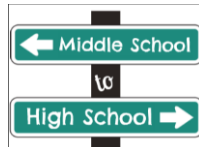

PROGRESS REPORTS

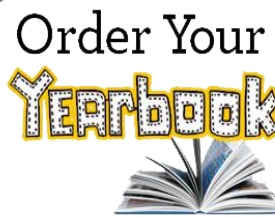
